

Articulation Agreements

Undergraduate:

Missouri Southern State University

Ozark Christian College has an articulation agreement with Missouri Southern State University for a dual-degree program: The Bachelor of Arts of Bible and Interdisciplinary Studies. Students complete a 125 credit hour BA at OCC and a Bachelor's degree of their choice at MSSU. Students must be accepted at both institutions according to their admissions applications and policies.

Students can transfer up to 40 hours to OCC from MSSU (at least 19 hours must be upper division courses. MSSU accepts general education courses as part of the agreement. Additional OCC courses may be accepted as electives at MSSU dependent on the academic program.

Please see the Academic Catalog for additional details. OCC has a designated academic advisor to help students at both OCC and MSSU.

4C Ministry Institute

Ozark Christian College accepts in transfer 4CMI courses listed in the Articulation Chart (see additional document) as equivalent to the corresponding OCC course as listed. Any student who enrolls at OCC is subject to OCC's admissions and academic policies. This articulation addresses transfer of credit only and does not alter OCC Admission policies.

Transfer is based on the faculty credentials and course syllabi presented to OCC. Any changes to this may result in the course(s) being treated according to normal OCC transfer policies. No more than two-thirds of the credit hours required for an OCC Bachelor's degree may be transferred into the OCC program.
